Once the application has been processed, students will receive a date and time for their interview, the majority of which will take place by telephone.

Unlike previous years, students will be asked to email a typed copy of their personal statement and details of where to send this will be in their interview letter. Personal statement guidelines can be found on the website by clicking on the 'Admissions Department' link within the 'Applications' box on the homepage

Interviews usually take place in November to March of the year preceding enrolment.
