Message from Mr Maltby





Good afternoon,

My communication today is in two parts. Following my weekly update there also follows a message from Louise Cullen, our Chair of Governors.

I want to begin my message by thanking Miss Mahoney and Mrs Beazley for their incredible work in preparing for students to return to school next week, together with the support of the Admin team in collating the consent responses from parents/carers. You will have received a letter confirming the date and time of when we expect your child next week and we very much look forward to welcoming them back to Holbrook Academy. Students will be receiving a copy of the attached leaflet when they return to school.

Secondly, I do want to update you on how the school is using additional catch-up money at this time. I am delighted to inform you that we have been accessing additional support for our students from the National Tutoring Project. This intervention is set alongside the literacy and numeracy support we continue to provide within our own Student Success Centre; which has continued to support students remotely throughout the lockdown period. I am also introducing Accelerated Reader to the lower school as I believe this is a really effective way of improving literacy and promoting reading. Further finance has contributed to our attendance provision; I am incredibly proud that overall attendance for Autumn Term 2020 was greater than Autumn Term 2019, despite the challenges that were present.

It is important that we are both informing and consulting in regards to how this additional money is being used; alongside being clear about the impact it is having. As our Academy re-opens to all students again, I am keen to respond to any specific concerns you might have about the impact lockdown might have had on your child's academic progress. Please can you provide any feedback using the email catchup@holbrookacademy.org; and this will then help to guide me in leading further intervention and support. I will also be providing further information on summer school support over the coming weeks.

As we move forward I am determined to ensure that all our students have every opportunity to fulfil their full potential.
