Good afternoon,

I attach to my weekly communication, arrangements for the staggered start to the new term in January. For those students who will not be on site for 5th January, we will ensure that we have live lessons streaming from the school site.

My decision-making at this time continues to be aligned with both national and local guidance; including Suffolk Public Health. I am also acutely aware of my wider responsibility as Headteacher of a community school ahead of the Christmas holiday. I have, therefore, made the decision, in agreement with Suffolk Public Health, that all students will be advised to wear a face-mask in their lessons next week; unless they are exempt from doing so.

I want to thank you again for your continuing support. I also want to thank my incredible colleagues for their collective response at this time.
