Uniform Expectations

We rely on your support to ensure that our uniform expectations are adhered to. Before the students arrive at school in the morning, their uniform is either correct or it is not. I must emphasise that we really value your support in tackling this issue but please do notify us if you would like further support. We can only assume that if you have not contacted us, your child has no reason not to be in the correct uniform. Therefore, your child will be challenged and appropriate sanctions will be put in place if their uniform is not rectified to meet our expectations.

Uniform Reminder 2022

All Students

- Black trousers (No jeans, 'skinny' or jean style trousers or leggings), or
- Black skirt (Knee length pleated or straight but not frilled or tight/figure hugging)
- Plain white shirt with Academy tie
- Navy jumper with Academy logo (Black jumper for Year 11)
- Plain black footwear

General Uniform Rules

- No coloured t-shirts to be worn under polo shirts
- Belts should be black and fit belt loops of school trousers/skirts
- Jewellery and make up should be discreet.
- Ear piercings should be discreet and consist of a single piercing in the earlobe, not bars and rings or studs at the top of the ear which can be a health and safety issue.
- A discreet nose stud is allowed but no other facial or body piercing is permitted, ie tongue, eyebrow, lip, etc
- No inappropriate hair colours/extreme styles experimentation with hair style / colour should be saved for the holidays.
- No long painted nails, acrylic or otherwise.
- No false eyelashes/eyelash extensions.
- Hats, bandanas, do-rags and other similar headwear are not permitted.
- Tights should be plain black or neutral colour and not patterned or lace.

On all issues of uniform, Form Tutors and staff from the Pastoral team will have the final say on what is discreet and appropriate for school.

A lunchtime detention will be set, if you do not have a valid note from parents/carers regarding your school uniform for the day.

Failure to attend the detention will result in an after school detention
