Uniform Reminder

Our uniform policy, which is a requirement of our school, is as follows:

- Boys:** Black school shoes (No trainers, boots, coloured soles/laces or open toe shoes)
Black trousers (No jeans, 'skinny' or jean style trousers)
Plain white polo shirt
School Sweatshirt Blue with Academy logo
- Girls:** Black school shoes (No trainers, boots, coloured soles/laces, open toe shoes, heels must be of no more than 5cm high)
Black skirt (Knee length, pleated or straight but not frilled, not to be worn with leggings)
(Plain black tights or socks may be worn with skirt but socks must not be worn together with tights)
Black trousers (No jeans, 'skinny', jean style trousers or leggings)
Plain white polo shirt
School Sweatshirt Blue with Academy logo
- Yr 11 Boys and Girls** As above in respect of trousers, skirts and footwear. Boys and girls in year 11 should wear black sweaters, shirts or blouses as appropriate and the Academy tie. Prefects are distinguished by a badge only.

GENERAL UNIFORM RULES

- **No coloured t-shirts** to be worn under polo shirts
- **Belts should be black** and fit belt loops of school trousers/skirts
- **Jewellery** and make up should be discreet
- **No facial or other body piercings** – this includes any facial piercing such as tongue, eyebrow, nose
- **No inappropriate hair colours/extreme styles** – experimentation with hair style/colour should be saved for the holidays
- **Hoodies, jackets and coats** should not be worn indoors
- **School shoes** may be canvas but must be plain black, no logo, coloured soles or laces
- **Bags** may be of backpack or holdall style and may be branded

On all issues of uniform, form tutors and staff from the Pastoral team will have the final say on what is discreet and appropriate for school.

Other items of uniform may be purchased elsewhere but must comply with the guidelines set out in the policy.

Breaches of uniform regulations will be reported by tutors to the Academy office daily. Parents will be notified by text that day and will be asked to deal with any issues for the following day. Failure to do this will result in appropriate sanctions being applied to students.
